2. CORPORAL AND COBBLER WILL BE COMMISSIONED IN TURKISH NAVY ON 21 NOV 1973 FOLLOWING OFFICIAL TRANSFER CEREMONY. OTHER DATES WILL BE SCHEDULED SEPARATELY AS REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAINING AND RFS/ISE ARE DEVELOPED. TURKISH DIGNITARIES ATTENDING CEREMONY AND TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS FOR TURKISH DELEGATION WILL BE PROVIDED SEPARATELY WHEN AVAILABLE.

3. FOLLOWING RESPONSIBILITIES ARE ASSIGNED;

A. FOR CINCLANTFLT

{1} MAKE CORPORAL AND COBBLER AVAILABLE AT GROTON, CONN. FOR TRANSFER CEREMONY 21 NOV 73.

{2} DECOMMISSION CORPORAL AND COBBLER ON 21 NOV 73 INCIDENT TO TRANSFER. DECOMMISSIONING WILL BE PART OF TRANSFER CEREMONY.

{3} PROVIDED ROUTING FOR HOMEWARD VOYAGE. PROVIDE OPERATIONAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT AS WELL AS ROUTING WHILE SHIP IS IN U.S. OPERATING AREAS DURING UNDERWAY TRAINING AND ISE.

{4} PROVIDE REQUESTED LOGISTIC SUPPORT IAW REFS E AND F.

{5} TRAINING WILL BE ADDRESSED BY SEPARATE MEANS.

{6} COORDINATE SCHEDULING OF EVENTS NOT ALREADY SCHEDULED IN THIS IMPLEMENTING DIRECTIVE.

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{7} FORWARD ONE COPY EACH OF LATEST EXISTING SHIPS' CHARACTERISTICS CARDS, LISTING OF INSTALLED ELECTRONICS, BOOKLET OF GENERAL ARRANGEMENT DRAWINGS, AND ONE SET EACH OF SHIPS PHOTOGRAPHS TO NAVAL INTELLIGENCE SUPPORT CENTER, ATTN: STIC-113. SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO SHIPS' CHARACTERISTICS CARDS AND LISTING OF ELECTRONICS EQUIPMENT SHOULD BE ENTERED IN PEN AND INK.

{8} ACT AS POINT OF CONTACT FOR ALL SUBORDINATE COMMANDS AND AGENCIES IN DISCHARGE OF THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES PURSUANT TO IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TRANSFERS.

{9} DESIGNATE A COMMAND TO:

{A} PERFORM DUTIES AS USN REPRESENTATIVE AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT TRANSFERS.

{B} CONDUCT CEREMONY FOR THE SHIP TRANSFERS ON 21 NOV 73 NO AUGMENTATION OF O&MN FUNDS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR CEREMONY, NOR WILL MAP FUNDS BE PROVIDED. CERTIFICATE OF DELIVERY AND GREETINGS FROM CNO FOR DELIVERY AT THE CEREMONY WILL BE PROVIDED SEPARATELY.

{C} COORDINATE ALL PUBLIC AFFAIRS ACTIONS AND PUBLICITY ASSOCIATED WITH THIS CEREMONY.

B. FOR CJUSMMAT ANKARA:

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{1} COORDINATE/CONTROL WITH ALCON INPUTS FOR REQUIREMENTS FOR MATERIAL AND FUNDING FOR ALL MATTERS INVOLVED IN THIS TRANSFER.

{2} REQUEST TURKISH CO'S OF SHIPS TO SUBMIT CRITIQUES CONTAINING COMMENTS AND SUGGESTIONS PERTAINING TO TRANSFER CEREMONY, TRAINING AND OTHER MATTERS INCIDENT TO TRANSFER TO OPNAV {OP-63} ON COMPLETION OF HOMEWARD VOYAGE.

{3} ADVISE OPNAV {OP-63} SOONEST OF SPECIFIC TRAINING REQUIREMENTS INCIDENT TO THIS TRANSFER.

{4} IF ORDANCE MATERIAL PURCHASE DESIRED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THIS TRANSFER, ADVISE TURKISH NAVY TO SUBMIT DIPLOMATIC NOTE SPECIFYING TYPES AND QUANTITY.

4. ADDITIONAL INFO AND GUIDANCE.

A. NO STRIPPING OTHER THAN THAT DIRECTED BY CNO IS AUTHORIZED. REMOVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT WHICH MAY BE ON BOARD: WELFARE AND RECREATION EQUIPMENT, ELECTRIC TYPEWRITERS AND CALCULATORS, SINUOUS COURSE CLOCK AND ALL CAMS, ALL CLASSIFIED CHARTS, PORT DIRECTORIES, AND ASSOCIATED PAPERS, ALL RADIAC EQUIPMENT AND BW/CW PROTECTIVE CLOTHING, ALL OPLANS/OPORDS, OFFICIAL RECORDS FOR HISTORICAL PURPOSES, INTELLIGENCE LIBRARY, AND ALL FILM

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PROJECTORS.

B. REF G PROVIDES GUIDANCE FOR RELEASE OF CLASSIFIED MATERIAL. CLASSIFIED MATERIAL NOT AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE SHOULD BE REMOVED PRIOR TO TRANSFER.

C. CUSTODY SIGNATURE FROM FOREIGN COMMANDING OFFICERS SHOULD BE OBTAINED FOR ALL CLASSIFIED MATERIAL TRANSFERRED AND COPY OF RECEIPTED LIST SHOULD BE FORWARDED TO CNO (OP-009D).

D. CONSUMABLES, INCLUDING FUEL, REPAIR PARTS AND COSAL MATERIAL WILL BE TRANSFERRED AT LEVELS ON BOARD AT TIME OF TURNOVER WITHOUT REIMBURSEMENT. SPARES AND CONSUMABLES SHOULD NOT BE SIGNIFICANTLY DRAWN DOWN PRIOR TO TURNOVER.

E. U.S. NAVY WILL BE REIMBURSED IAW REFS E AND F AND FOR ANY PROVISIONS LEFT ON BOARD AT TIME OF TURNOVER. MAP FUNDS CANNOT BE UTILIZED FOR PROVISIONS.

F. BOTH CORPORAL AND COBBLER WILL BE LOADED WITH 9 EACH TORPEDOES MK-37 MOD 2 AND 5 EACH TORPEDOES MK-37 MOD 3 AS PART OF USN/TURKISH NAVY TORPEDO EXCHANGE PROGRAM. SMALL ARMS AND AMMO MAY BE RETAINED ON BOARD. UPON ARRIVAL CORPORAL AND COBBLER IN TURKEY, RETURN MATERIAL TO NAD CRANE AT TN EXPENSE. US NAVY TO BE REIMBURSED FOR

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SHORTAGES. SUBMIT REPORTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH REF H.

G. PYROTECHNICS AND EVASION DEVICES. TRANSFER WITH NORMAL ALLOWANCE OF:

{1} PYROTECHNICS, EXCEPT SEIS SHALL BE LIMITED TO NORMAL NUMBER OF RED ONLY. NO GREEN, YELLOW OR BLACK SEIS WILL BE TRANSFERRED.

{2} FTC EVASION DEVICES. NO NAE BEACONS WILL BE TRANSFERRED.

H. EXISTING GALLEY EQUIPMENT, BEDDING AND LINEN AND FOUL WEATHER GEAR WILL BE TRANSFERRED AT NO COST.

I. TEST EQUIPMENT, NAVIGATIONAL EQUIPMENT, MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES, AND ALL DECK EQUIPAGE WILL BE TRANSFERRED AT NO COST.

J. CANCELLATION ACTION SHOULD BE TAKEN ON USN-INITIATED REQUISITIONS FOR SPARE PARTS AND CONSUMABLES THAT CANNOT BE DELIVERED ON BOARD BY TRANSFER DATE.

K. SPARE PARTS AND CONSUMABLES NEEDED FOR HOMEWARD VOYAGE CAN BE REQUISITIONED ON A FILL-OR-KILL BASIS IAW REFS E AND F.

L. CASUALTY, ACCIDENT AND HOSPITALIZATION REPORTS ON FOREIGN PERSONNEL WILL BE REPORTED IAW REF I.

M. AFTER TURNOVER, SHIPS WILL PROCEED UNDER COMMAND OF FOREIGN

CO'S AS COMMISSIONED SHIPS OF THE TURKISH NAVY.

N. LOGISTICS SUPPORT OF SHIPS AFTER COMMENCEMENT OF HOMEWARD VOYAGE IS RESPONSIBILITY OF TURKISH NAVY.

O. PREFERRED CURATORIAL ITEMS EXCEPT VALVE WHEELS AND LABELS PLATES WILL BE FORWARDED TO THE CURATOR OF THE DEPT OF NAVY IAW REF J APPENDIX 4.

P. PREVIOUS SHIP TRANSFERS HAVE EXPERIENCED PROBLEMS WITH LOSS OF HIGHLY PILFERABLE ITEMS SUCH AS FOUL WEATHER GEAR, BLANKETS, CLOCKS AND BINOCULARS. INSURE APPROPRIATE SECURITY MEASURES ARE TAKEN TO SAFEGUARD SUCH ITEMS WHICH MUST PROPERLY REMAIN WITH THE SHIP AFTER TRANSFER.

REQUEST ACTION ADDEES AND SUBORDINATE COMMANDS DELEGATED ACTION INCIDENT TO THIS TRANSFER ASSIGN ACTION OFFICERS RESPONSIBLE FOR CARRYING OUT THIS DIRECTIVE AND PROVIDE NAMES AND AUTOVON TELEPHONE NUMBERS TO CINCLANT AND OPNAV {OP-63}. OPNAV ACTION OFFICER IS MR. E.W. SEITZ, AUTOVON 225 2951/6382.

6. DIRLAUTH ALCON TO EFFECT TRANSFER.
