## Sub Corporal Rejoins Fleet at Charleston

CHARLESTON—The submarine to Corporal was recommissioned in ceremonies at the Naval Base here July 20, marking her return to the fleet after a six-month conversion.

The Corporal is now a GUPPY III submarine, making her much more potent than her unmodified diesel-electric sisters. Her hull has been lengthened 15 feet to provide space for new electronic gear and additional crew berthing space.

Her conning tower has also been lengthened to permit installation of a new attack center and a new plastic sail has been added.

Originally commissioned in 1945, she is now assigned to Charleston's Submarine Squadron 4.
